Under general supervision, performs social services functions at an advanced level to male and female individuals, between the ages of 12 and 17, with substance abuse history. The candidate will serve as point of contact for youth and families with community resources, and will provide check-ins (school, drug court, etc.), conflict resolution around recovery support, motivational support, as well as conduct life skill groups, family groups, and substance abuse groups. The candidate will provide transportation from school to program and home, transporting to and from local activities. The candidate will also provide documentation daily.

Days & Hours: Monday - Friday, 11am to 7pm and rotating Saturdays.

Minimum Qualifications:

Completion of a Bachelor's degree in a helping field, and two years of experience in the social services field. At least two years of experience working with mental health and/or substance abuse population, conducting group. Must have excellent customer service skills.

The selected applicant must furnish the required documentation authorizing work in the United States as well as pass a criminal background investigation and drug screening.
