Job Description

Under general supervision, performs social services functions by engaging with individuals with serious mental illness who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless; and assisting them with accessing stable housing and linkage to mainstream mental health services.

Minimum Qualifications:

Applicant must have a high school diploma. **Must submit proof with application.** One-Two years of full-time experience as a case manager in a social service setting or experience will individuals experiencing homelessness who are seriously mental ill.

Preferred Qualifications:

Completion of a bachelor's degree in one of the following fields: social work, psychology, mental health, nursing, education, sociology, criminal justice, counseling, rehabilitation counseling, guidance counseling, or a related discipline.

Applicant MUST submit proof of High School or GED completion with application to be considered for employment
