Provide oversight to the IPS Supported Employment program. Manage daily operations of program. Monitor outcomes and implement quality improvement plans as needed. Act as a liaison with other agencies and departments. Direct and supervise program staff. Submit monthly reports. Chart compliance. Update treatment plans as needed.

Minimum Qualifications:

Master's degree from a recognized college or university in rehabilitation counseling or related field is preferred. Degree and experience must meet requirements for Medicaid for approved Medicaid Provider status. Previous experience in mental health field is preferred. Previous supervisory experience is valued. Must be licensed in GA or license eligible.

Preferred Qualifications:

Supervisory and Program Management preferred.

Experience in working with individuals with mental disorders and/or addictive diseases are preferred.
