Assists with basic assessments to determine functional abilities. Uses observational skills to remain aware of behavior and physical conditions, and other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

Applicant must have a high school diploma or GED. **Must submit proof with application.** Must possess a valid Georgia driver's license.

Experience working with individuals with developmental disabilities.
