Job Description

The EMERGE Listening, Inspiring, & Guiding Healthy Transitions (LIGHT) Program is an Early Treatment Program (ETP), and has a team-based, multi-element approach to treating transition-aged youth and young adults, ages 16 to 30, with First Episode Psychosis (FEP).

The candidate will serve as a Case Manager for the FEP Program and will support adolescents and young adults who are experiencing early stages of mental illness. This non-clinical role focuses on providing essential services, resources, and guidance to help clients achieve their personal recovery goals.

This position serves the following counties: **Muscogee, Harris, Talbot, Chattahoochee, Stewart, Randolph, Quitman, and Clay.**

This position is from Monday to Friday, 8am to 5pm. Some weekends and/or evenings may be required.

Minimum Qualifications:

A Bachelor's degree in social or human services field (i.e.: social work, sociology, psychology, etc.) with at least 2 years' experience in social services, mental health, or a related field. Experience with documentation and maintaining client records. Strong organizational and communication skills. **Transportation is required, a valid driver's license is essential, and an insured personal vehicle is needed.**

Preferred Qualifications:

Previous experience in case management.
