Job Description

The System of Care Coordinator/Generation Next Program Director provides community-based services and supports for children and young adults with (or at risk of) mental health challenges. The SOC works closely with other programs to ensure families are supported and youth needs are met through grant resources and deliverables. Responsibilities are managing daily operations of the program; intakes and assessments; therapy and groups; linkage to resources; monthly reports; clinical documentation; liaison to community partners, serving on boards as needed; attend resource fairs. Must be flexible and must believe in teamwork.

Minimum Qualifications:

Master's degree in Counseling or Social Work from an accredited program AND Licensure in the area of assignment (**or License eligible**). Prior experience working with youth and adults in a mental health setting and/or school. At least two (2) years of supervisory experience. Strong clinical skills, in addition to excellent communication & written skills.

Preferred Qualifications

Licensed or license eligible- **LPC, LAPC, LCSW, LMFT, or LAMFT.**
