### **Job Description**

The candidate will provide clinical support through individual, group, and family therapy to individuals navigating mental health challenges. This role involves delivering therapeutic interventions, offering emotional support, and connecting clients with community resources. In addition, the candidate will advocate for clients within mental health and social service systems to ensure they receive necessary support and accommodations. Also, ongoing monitoring, documentation, and reporting.

Population served: Males and females, ages 16-30; first time psychosis.

# **Minimum Qualifications:**

Licensed Counselor in the state of Georgia. Must be an LPC, LCSW, LAPC, LMFT or LMSW. Must possess strong clinical, communication, and problem-solving skills. Must have a valid driver's license, reliable transportation, and a clean driving record, as the candidate may have to transport.

## **Preferred Qualifications:**

Previous experience in individual, group, and family therapy.
