Job Description

Under general to limited supervision, the candidate will perform social services functions at an advanced level to individuals and their families. **Must have experience working with persons with SPMI.** Will be responsible for working with individuals who are mandated to treatment and reporting to court. Must have skills in documentation, communication with individuals, family, and community resources expected.

Minimum Qualifications:

Master's Degree in social work, psychology, or counseling. Degree must be license-eligible if unlicensed. If licensed, must be LCSW, LMSW, LPC, or LAPC. **Must be licensed in the state of Georgia.** Must have experience working with computers. Must have a valid driver's license and a clean driving record.

Preferred Qualifications:

At least 2 years of experience working with individuals with mental disorders and/or addictive diseases.

The selected applicant must furnish the required documentation authorizing work in the United States as well as pass a criminal background investigation and drug screening.
